#### **A BRIEF PROFILE :**

The LIBERAL COLLEGE, Luwangsangbam established in the year 1979, is the outcome of long cherished will and desire of the people in the area. This ALMA MATER was named "LIBERAL COLLEGE" unanimously in a historic public meeting presided overby the then Hon'ble MLA, Heingang Assembly Constituency, Shri L. Ningthemjao Singh convened on the June 3, 1979 along with the four Pradhans of GramPanchayats of the Heingang Assembly Constituency namely (i) Shri Md. Asraf Ali, Heingang G.P (ii) Shri Y. Kalachand Singh, Laipham Khunou G.P (iii) Shri P. Mangi Singh, Kontha Khabam G.P and (iv) Shri Y. Mangi Singh, Luwangsangbam G.P at the premises of the SrivanHigh School, Luwangsangbam. The College is about 7 km. away towards the northern side of Imphal City and Western side of the National Highway No. 2. The first regular Classesstarted on the 10th August, 1979 at the premises of the Srivan High School, Luwangsangbam.

The foundation stone of the College was laid by Sri R.K. Dorendro Singh, the then Hon'ble Chief Minister of Manipur on the 19th October, 1980. The location of the college in a beautiful landscape far away from the din and bustle of the city provides a very good and sound academic atmosphere for various courses of studies. The College has also been been included in 2 (f) and 12-B under section - 2(f) of the UGC Act 1956 vide UGC orders No.F. 8/28/95 (CPP-I) of dt. 19-02-98.

Liberal College opens Classes for T.D.C. (B.A./B.Sc./B.Com.) streams (six semester system). It has opened General and Honours courses for B.A./B.Sc./B.Com.. The Collegehas permanently been affiliated to the Manipur University, Canchipur w.e.f. 27/03/1992 upto T.D.C. IIIrd Year Arts, Science & Commerce, Vide M.U. Orders No. MU/2-1/180/CDC/4755 dated 27/03/92. The College has been extended recurring Grant-in-Aid College by the Govt. of Manipur w.e.f. Feb. 1987. The College is run by the Registered Governing Body. It is a society registered under Society Registration Act XXI of 1960 under Regd.No. 4408 of 1983 as authority of the college. It has proved its existence for the last 39 years during which period the pace of development and expansion of the college is very rapid and significant by dint of the dedicated services rendered by the employees, localeducationists

and specially by the Governing Body of the College to a great extent.

Liberal College is a Co-educational institution having its own enough infrastructures. There is a separate Arts and Science Block. ### **B.A./BSc.BCom** (Programme)

## Under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) with Learning Outcome based Curriculum Framework (LOCF) Manipur University

Course Structure for B.A/BSc/BCom (Programme) framed under M.U Ordinance for Undergraduate Programme in Arts, Science and Commerce, 2021.

There are total eighteen Core Courses that students are required to take across eight semesters. All the Core Courses are compulsory. In addition to Core Courses, a student of BA/BSc/BCom Programme will choose four Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Courses, Six Generic Elective Courses (GEC) and eight value addition courses.

The Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Courses are offered in the last four semesters of the 4 Year degree programme namely the fifth, sixth, seventh and eight Semesters.

The Generic elective courses which are meant for students of other departments are being offered from  $3^{rd}$  semester to  $8^{th}$  semester ( see table below). The students are required to take 6 (six) Generic Elective courses during the whole programme, one per semester running from  $3^{rd}$  semester to  $8^{th}$  semester.

There are two compulsory papers for every student in first and second Semester. AECC-01 (English/MIL) and AECC-02 (EVS) respectively

Mark distribution and Evaluation

Total marks for each course shall be based on Internal assessment (25%) and semester end examination (75%). The internal assessment of 25 % shall be distributed as under

### > CAMPUS FACILITIES:

#### **Computer Class :**

The college has a vocational computer add on diploma courses for 6 (six) months in addition with the general regular course under Rastriya Uchchattar Shiksha Avhiyan (RUSA). Students are selected purely on the merit basis and completed students are provided certificate of Diploma in Computer for 6 months.

#### Library :

The College has a well stocked & academic Library building which can provide a lot of Text Books/References/Additional & Special resource materials/documents for the students/the teachers of different faculties/classes in accordance with different academic disciplines. The Library always provides different types of newspapers, bulletins, periodicals, magazines, journals & a number of resource materials for information technology in order to provide the upliftment & improvement to the academic career of every student of the College. The Library also provides a well organised & systematic form of Reading Rooms, Urinal/Lavatory facilities for both students & employees of the college. The Library of the College always supplies all the important books & other resource materials prescribed by Manipur University & Teachers of the College from time to time. The Library has the scope & planning of maintaining all the infra-structure of modern information technology including Computers, Television & other audio-visual aids facilities at present.

#### Vehicle Shed :

The College has a large & well constructed vehicle Shed for stationing different ypes of vehicles including cycles, two wheeler & four wheelers, etc which can give convenience to the students, employees of the College during the Class & Office hours. This vehicle Shed is well-fenced & guarded with tight security under the observation of a Chowkidar during the Office hour in the general interest of the student community & employees of the College.



#### Student's Union Office, Boy's and Girl's Common Rooms :

The College has well constructed Student's Union Office & separate Common Rooms for both Boys & Girls which are well-equipped with newspapers, periodicals, magazines, first-aid facilities of medical treatment & various indoor games, etc.

#### Games and Sports :

The College has a well constructed playground inside the campus where different types of outdoor games such as Football, Hockey, Cricket & Athletic events can be exhibited/organised with all modern sports facilities. An inter house Games & Sports Meet is held annually for every academic session. The College organises different tournaments of cricket, football, etc. in order to select competent players for participating in the inter-college sports' Championship & Tournament. The College has already contributed/gained produced a number of excellent sportspersons in different fields of Games & Sports who can enlighten the glory & fame of the college in the State-Level & National-Level Sports' Meets. The college has its own Indoor Stadium & Multipurpose hall. The College has also organised the first co-operation & guidance of the All Manipur Football Association (AMFA). Now, it has been converted into (late) N. Surendra Men's Best Physique since 2009-10. The Manipur University is organising this sport annually.

#### **Canteen:**

The college has a canteen its own for the interest & welfare of the students & employees of the college. The Canteen provides a number of common edible food materials such as tea, milk, sweets, cold drinks, etc. at the minimum prices as far as possible.

#### N.C.C.:

The NCC Unit is opened within the Campus itself. This facilities, however are for boys only from all streams by joining the college in XI or degree. NCC provides the students with many incentives such as certificates, awards etc. Interested candidates can contact NCC cell for enrolment.

#### N.S.S. :

The College has N.S.S. (Unit- I & II) for the upliftment of the students in various activities of the college & the society. The N.S.S. Unit always take a great responsibility & participation in many social works of natural calamities as well as progressive & development works of the college & the society. So, the N.S.S. Unit of the college should be organised as a strong force for the welfare of the college & the society so that the participants in the N.S.S. Units will be the future social workers & leaders of the state. The



N.S.S. Units of the college will be preserved & regarded as the stepping stone in the development of the social structure towards prosperity & emotional integration of the country.

In addition to these facilities mentioned above, the college has a number of programmes & activities to be organised/developed in the near future with a good system of policy and planning for the welfare of the student community & the employees of the college.

### Hostel :

The college has its own 50 bedded pucca boys' hostel equipped with hygienic andhealth care facilities. Priority accommodation will be given to the students coming from far off districts/states.

A 200 bedded SC/ST/OBC Girls' Hostel is also started functioning after inauguration by Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India during the month of April 2018. The girls' hostel is equipped with modern hygienic wash rooms / toilets. The hostel has basketball as well as volleyball court separately inside the hostel boundary itself.
